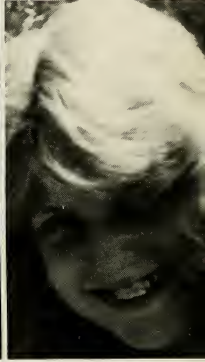
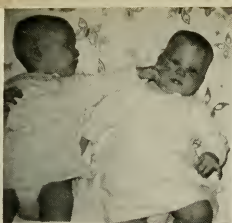
DEDICATION
